**Step 4:** Attend Subject Selection Interview (parent with child)

**Year 12, 2018 Monday, August 21**

**Year 11, 2018 Wednesday, August 23**

**Step 5:** Receive confirmation of subject choices by early Term 4

# Year 10 at Cornerstone

**Core subjects:** Compulsory for all students

- Christian Living
- English
- History (one semester)
- Mathematics
- Personal Learning Plan (PLP)
- Physical Education
- Science

**Electives:**

5 semester long subjects to be selected for the year from comprehensive list



# Year 11 at Cornerstone

- Compulsory requirements of the SACE
  - English (full year)
  - Mathematics (at least one semester)
- Students at Cornerstone College also study
  - Christian Living (2 lessons)
  - Health & Fitness (2 lessons)
  - 1 supervised study lesson
- **Electives:**
  - **7 semester long elective subjects**
  - **2 reserves**





# Year 12 at Cornerstone

At Cornerstone Year 12 students studying full time have:

- Christian Living (1 lesson/week, 3 terms)
- Research Project
- **4 subjects (or 3 subjects and VET)**
- 4 study lessons per week initially

*For VET students a reduced subject load at school will be negotiated*

## LA Leader - Mr Michael Murphy

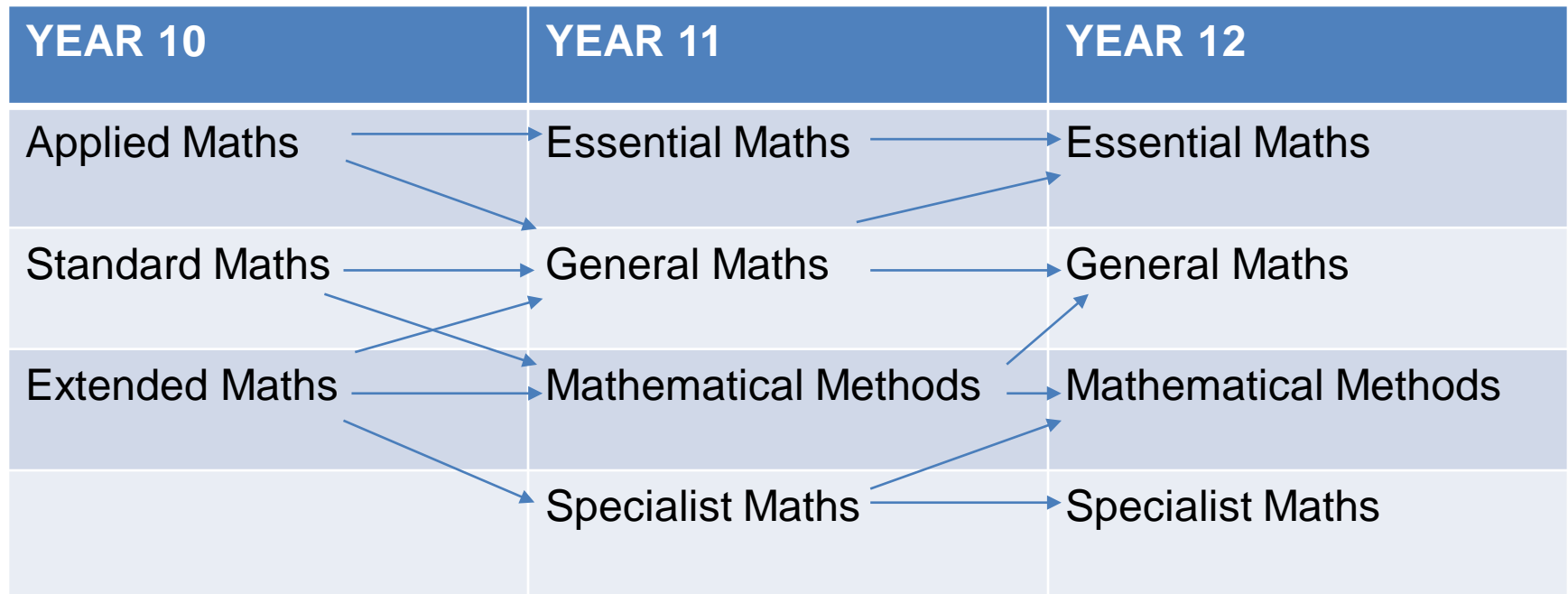
- Various Options – advised by teacher

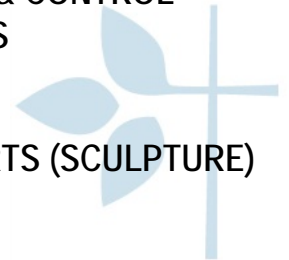
